The Government of Pakistan has received financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and the Italian Agency for Development Cooperation (AICS) towards the cost of the Economic Transformation Initiative and intends to hire rented vehicles for Department of Cooperatives Gilgit Baltistan under MoA.

2. Bids received after the due time and date shall be summarily rejected.
3. Bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the bidding documents, must be delivered to the respective offices by **11:00 a.m.** on or before **October 01, 2026**. Bids will be opened publicly on **October 01, 2026**, at **11:30 a.m.** in the ETI-GB office, in the presence of firms or their authorized representatives who choose to attend.
4. If the last date for bid submission falls within an official holiday or weekend of the Purchaser, the last date shall stand extended to the next working day.
5. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of not less than **3%** (refundable) in the name of **Programme Coordination Unit Gilgit** of the bid price, in the form of a Bank Draft or CDR issued by a scheduled bank.
6. The procuring entity reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of the requisite items.
7. Firms will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the PPRA/IFAD Project Procurement Handbook, accessible via the websites of PPRA (www.ppra.org.pk) and IFAD (www.ifad.org/project-procurement).
