Terms & Conditions.

1. Tender documents having details specification along with terms and conditions may downloaded from the official website of GB PPRa: <https://www.gbppra.gov.pk/> or from the office of the Deputy Secretary (Prosecution) Law & Prosecution Department New Secretariat Building Jutail Gilgit.
2. Separate sealed envelopes of tenders for each category may be submitted in the office of the Secretary Law & Prosecution Department GB, Gilgit upto 11:00 AM to 01:00 PM of the date of opening of tenders.
3. The tenders will be opened on the given date & time in presence of the contractors/Suppliers, or their authorized Reps
4. Name of Category must be written in bold on the sealed envelope.
5. A Firm/Contractor/Supplier may offer tenders for one or more categories.

6. Single Stage One Envelope as per Rule 39(a) of GBPPRA Rules 2022 method will be adopted. The sealed envelope of tenders must contain the following documents, without which the tender will be liable to be rejected.
- i) Bidders must provide proof of having an operational Sales Center/shop/Workshop in Gilgit City.
 - ii) Bidders must provide proof of at least 3 years of experience in supplying similar equipment to public or private sector organizations.
 - iii) Updated Bank Statement of the firm.
 - iv) Call Deposit from a Scheduled Bank.
 - v) Registration certificate of firm, with latest renewal (if any)
 - vi) Copy of CNIC of the owner.
 - vii) Rates of items must be filled in computerized on the Firm's letter paid with vender number.
 - viii) Rates of items must be in accordance to the market. Unjustified rates/zero rates will not be accepted.
 - ix) Non-Blacklisted affidavit on stamp paper of Rs. 100/-.
7. The rates of items if not covered in the "Tender Form" will be determined in accordance with the retail price fixed by the Chairman Price control Committee, Gilgit/Market Rates.
8. Govt. Taxes applicable (if any) will be borne by the Firm/Contractor/Supplier.
9. Cost of Tender Copy/Bidding Documents must be deposited through treasury challan and attach the copy of challan with the Tender Copy/Bidding Documents and submit to this department on due date.
10. All bidders must comply with the terms and conditions specified in the tender documents. Non-compliance may result in rejection of the bid.
