Prescribed Form/Bidding Documents containing detailed terms and conditions may be obtained from the office of the Inspector General Prisons, Gilgit-Baltistan, near Airport Old District Jail Office, Gilgit, during office hours.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The bidder shall submit the earnest money in the form of a **Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)** issued by any scheduled bank in favor of the **DDO, Inspector General Prisons, Gilgit-Baltistan**, along with the bid documents.
2. Bids submitted with incomplete supporting documents or containing false or misleading information shall be rejected and may render the bidder liable to legal action.
3. The successful bidder shall deliver, provide, install, repair or execute the required supply/work after issuance of the Supply/Work Order by the Inspector General Prisons Department, Gilgit-Baltistan.
4. The bidder shall attach **one-year bank statement** showing transactions of approximately **Rs. 5.00 million**, with a minimum closing balance of **Rs. 2 million**.
5. Unrealistic rates, whether excessively high or unusually low, conditional bids, incomplete bids or item-wise missing quotations shall be rejected outright.
6. An affidavit on **non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.50/-** declaring that the bidder has never been blacklisted by any Government, Semi-Government, Autonomous or Private Organization shall be submitted with the bid. All submitted documents must be duly attested.
7. The successful contractor/firm shall be bound to supply the required items throughout the Financial Year **2026-27** at the quoted rates without any revision.
8. The contractor/firm must be registered or enlisted with a recognized Government Department, Authority or Organization.
9. The tender shall be evaluated in accordance with the **Gilgit-Baltistan Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (GBPPRA) Rules, 2022** under **Rule 36(b): Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure**.
10. All bidders shall attach the prescribed **Treasury Challan** along with their Technical Proposal/Documents.
11. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in accordance with the provisions of the **GBPPRA Rules, 2022**, after recording reasons where required.
12. In case the tender opening date falls on a gazetted or local holiday, the bids shall be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue without any further notice.
13. **Only the Technical Proposals** shall be opened on the opening date and time mentioned above. The **Financial Proposals** of only those bidders who qualify the technical evaluation shall be opened on a later date, which shall be communicated separately to the technically qualified bidders.
